## TEACHERS FOCUS GROUP BELGIUM

As part of Working Package 2, the project team is working on the co-creation of 5 intercultural board games. SIRIUS is participating in the co-creation of the Belgian version of the game, in collaboration with Stepping Stones, a Montessori bilingual school where most of the students are non-Belgian, and interculturality is part of everyday life.

During the first focus group with a group of six teachers, they shared their thoughts on the role of play in promoting intercultural understanding in their classrooms. The teachers highlighted the importance of creating a sense of belonging and supporting the autonomy of students to facilitate their inclusion in the classroom.



# NEXT STEPS

At the beginning of the 2024–2025 school year, we will continue the co-creation process of the game by holding a focus group with the parents and families of the school. Following this, we will host a co-creation workshop involving children, parents, and teachers to test the game and gather feedback and ideas from the school community.
